Records of Ban Laem's deep connection with the water dates back to the Rama V period, when the former King visited the surrounding area of Suphanburi, and the village was featured in a poem written by Sunthorn Phu, who accompanied him on his journey. Also known as "Bang Pla Ma", visitors can enjoy boat rides across the water, ride a tractor through the fields (to collect duck eggs in the morning) or even try riding one of the well-trained buffalo to avoid getting stuck in the mud! Local cooking and craft classes are also popular in Ban Laem.

- Learn how to make traditional Thai desserts
- Learn how to cook traditional dishes.
- Making colorful herbal incenses.
- Learn about integrated farming and collect duck eggs.
- Collect water hyacinth and weave carps from water hyacinth.
- Take a boat ride to explore riverside community.

- Learn about rice farming and take a look at thai water buffaloes.

- Explore places visited by the famous royal poet, Sunthorn Phu.

- Discover traditional Thai houses built during King Rama V's reign.
- Floating houses.
- Take a boat ride to Wat Pa Pruek. Pay respect to the replica of Lord Buddha's Footprint, Luang Phor Si Saeng Buddha statue and hit 88 bells.
- Visit the museum displaying artifacts from the late Ayutthaya period such as manuscript and ancient Thai boat replica.

- Learn how to cook Tom Yum Pla Ma (Spicy soldier croaker soup).
- Visit Monthathip Farm, an integrated farm based on the late King's

Sufficiency Economy Philosophy.

Morning Breakfast and prepare to check out.

10.00 am. Head to the Lifestyle and Spirit of Thai Farmers Learning Center (Nahai Chai).

10.30 am. Arrive at the Lifestyle and Spirit of Thai Farmers Learning Center (Nahai

Chai). The center was founded to show allegiance to King Rama IX, who worked hard out of his concern for the Thai people. The objective of this center is to develop high-quality rice to meet the needs of rice farmers and to provide knowledge about proper rice farming. Visitors will realize the

importance of rice and rice farmers.

Head to Sa Pan Khong Floating Market. 01.00 pm.

02.00 pm. Arrive at Sa Pan Khong Floating Market, the new tourist destination of

Suphan Buri. Shop for goods from boat vendors along the lengthy bamboo

bridge. Enjoy stunning scenery at the top of Ban Ton Tan tower.

Head to Bangkok. 02.30 pm.

04.30 pm. Arrive back in Bangkok, end of trip.
